

Essential Evaluation of Your Retina

One of the most important parts of today's eye exam is the examination of the inside of your eye (the retina).

A healthy retina is critical to your vision and needs to be examined (with Dilation or Optomap) for the pre-symptomatic signs of macular degeneration, glaucoma, retinal holes, and retinal melanomas.

The lack of symptoms does not mean the lack of disease.....All patients should choose either Dilation or Optomap.

Choice 1 – Dilation * Traditional evaluation of the retinal surface using eye drops (may cause blurred vision or light sensitivity for ~2-3 hours). Recommended for patients with new retinal symptoms, diabetes, or those not choosing to have the Optomap on a yearly basis. There is no additional charge for dilation.

Choice 2 – Optomap * Wide angle digital scan of the retinal surface (no drops). Optomap may reduce the frequency of recommended dilations and may be done individually (\$30) or as part of the "Enhanced Exam" Options (\$35 or \$45)

No Dilation or Optomap - *Against the recommendation of Dr. Anderson, I have chosen not to have either of the above tests performed. Enhanced Exam Options

Our ability to use modern/advanced technology during your examination has drastically improved. You now have the opportunity to choose a "**Basic Exam**" (1980's technology covered by most insurance plans) or an "**Enhanced Exam**" (early detection and tracking technology covered by an additional fee). Detecting eye problems early (before you notice your first symptoms) improves your opportunity to correct and avoid vision loss and irreversible blindness. Although these tests are optional, Dr John and Dr Terri Anderson highly recommend the "**Enhanced Exam**" tests and the use of this newer technology to protect your sight.

Enhanced Option 2– (Rec. for 10-17 year olds) **OR** **Enhanced Option 3–** (Rec. for 18 -100+ year olds)

Fast Field + Optomap + iWellness = **\$45**
